Hobart's Sanders, Keuka's Josephson

Named RACA Athletes of the Week

Hobart football linebacker Jeff Sanders and Keuka women's soccer sweeper Kelly Josephson are the Rochester Area College Athletics Athletes of the Week for Nov. 3-9.

Sanders led the Statesmen Saturday to a 20-17 upset of previously unbeaten Rensselaer, which was ranked 17th in NCAA Division III. The RACA Male Athlete of the Week had a game-high 14 tackles, recovered a fumble and was credited with half a sack. The senior from Camden, N.Y. (Camden High School) was instrumental in holding Rensselaer 15 points below its season scoring average.

Josephson – a junior from Jamestown, N.Y. (Maple Grove HS) – led the Storm to a NEAC Tournament title to add to its first-place finish during the regular season at 7-0-1. She was named the conference Player of the Year and tournament Most Valuable Player. The RACA Female Athlete of the Week anchored a defense that allowed only one goal in three tournament games. With Josephson leading the way, Keuka led the conference in shutouts, fewest goals allowed and lowest goals-against average.

Earning Honorable Mention were William Smith women's soccer player Ali Art, RIT women's swimmer Caitlyn Burr, SUNY Brockport men's ice hockey defenseman Mike Gershon, Keuka men's soccer player Brandon Scott and Nazareth men's cross country runner Nick Stenuf.

Twelve athletes were nominated for the awards.
